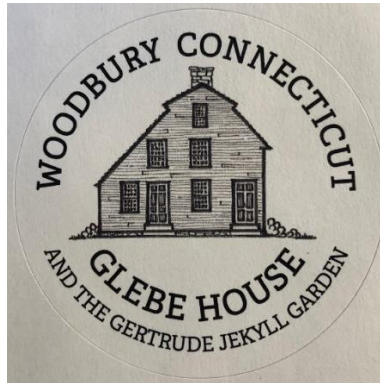


Join the
